



Policy on Games cancelled due to weather:

Your child's safety is important to us.

Occasionally, we will be forced to cancel scheduled baseball or softball games due to Thunder/Lightning storms.

These cancellations do not usually occur until the actual game time.

Since this is the case, please have your child at the field, at the scheduled game time, regardless of what the weather has been like throughout the day.

The only time you shouldn't show up is if your manager calls you prior to game time and lets you know that the game has been cancelled.

Any games cancelled during a weekday will be made up on the Saturday of the same week. For example, if a game is cancelled on Tuesday, the make up game will be scheduled for Saturday of that week. Your manager will communicate the make up game time to you prior to Saturday.

We also do our best to get make up game schedules posted on our web site at www.howellbaseball.com.

If inclement weather, such as lightning and thunder become present just prior to a game, or during a game, a large yellow flag, will become visible by the concession stand. The Yellow Flag indicates that all scheduled games are on hold, and that kids and parents should seek shelter in their vehicle. If after 20 minutes, the weather has not improved, the large Yellow Flag will be replaced by a large **Red Flag**, designating that the games have been cancelled for the day. If the Yellow Flag is removed, and no other flag is put into its place, this indicates that the games in progress can resume. **The umpire does not have the ability to cancel a game. The Field commissioner on site makes this decision from the concession stand.**
